Dr Kofi Korsah is a former Capstone Ministries board member until he retired from his position at Oak Ridge National Lab as a nuclear engineer a few years ago. He returned to his native Ghana in west Africa and started an engineering firm as a ministry to those in his community. He visited Knoxville recently and was introduced to Capstone's "Make Disciples" booklet. Upon returning to Ghana he shared the material with two pastors. One of the pastors, James Nda Korsah (pictured above with his son in the upper right) wanted to use it to share the gospel and disciple students in unreached Nzema land in western Ghana.

Ghana has a national law that religion must be taught in the public schools. Teachers of any religious background are welcome to come into the schools to share their faith. James has been sharing his Christian faith with 2,000 middle and high school level students in this more remote Nzema land. He liked the Capstone discipleship study and asked to share it with the students under his instruction.

Kofi had 100 copies of the study printed and it was very well received. Capstone then donated funds for another 500 copies-with more to come to reach all 2,000. Joseph has been taking the study to multiple classrooms- both indoor and outdoor- as noted above. Many of the non-believing young people have come to a saving faith and they are being disciplined.

Ghana also has a requirement that all college graduates do a one year public service after graduation- usually in needy rural areas. One option is to share the gospel during that time. Possibly some of these students may be college bound and willing to serve. God has opened a tremendous opportunity to “make disciples” in Ghana as Jesus commanded in Mt 28.
